Ladies Category (Open) (Cancelled)	 Participant to be minimally 16 years old as of 1st Jan 2024 Maximum of 10 players per team (5 players and 5 reserves) Minimum of 6 teams and maximum of 8 teams

• In the event where minimum number of teams is not met, the organiser has the rights to decide whether or not the event shall be cancelled.

Rules & Regulations

Eligibility of Players

- This tournament is open for all nationality residing in Singapore.
- Entries are accepted on a first-come-first-serve-basis.
- SAFRA member with a valid membership as of event date to enjoy member's rate.
- The Organiser has the right to check the eligibility of a player during the tournament.
 Anyone found to have breach the eligibility criteria shall be disqualified from the tournament.

Registration

- Team Managers / Captains shall undertake the responsibility of ensuring the health and well-being of their Players competing in this Tournament.
- Each team shall comprise a maximum of 10 (10) players (5 Players & 5 Reserves)
- The Team Manager, Coach and Official will be allowed to play if they are registered as Players only.
- Only players whose names are registered in the Team are allowed to play in the match.
- All current FAS registered National and SPL are not eligible to participate in this tournament.
- All Participants/Team Managers/Captains are required to report at the registration counter with their NRICs/Photo IDs and to confirm their teams' registration and attendance.
- The decision of the Chief Referee appointed by the Organising Committee on any question of interpretation of the rules arising during the tournament shall be final.
- Registration is non-refundable, in the event of cancellation/ no-show.



Verification

- The Team Manager/Captain shall undertake the responsibility of ensuring the eligibility of their players competing in this tournament.
- Any Teams found guilty of fielding unregistered players will be disqualified from the tournament.

Tournament Format

Format of Play

- All matches must be played according to the fixtures and no postponement is allowed.
- Round-Robin will last for 10 minutes (No Intervals) with Semi-final and Final lasting for 14 minutes per match.

- The points awarded will be 3 points for Win, 1 point for Draw, 0 point for Loss.
- Teams should report to the court officials for their matches, 2 minutes before their match begins. Announcements will be made accordingly.
- Top two teams from each group will progress to the next stage.
- Teams placed 3rd and 4th of each group will then have a one-game play off. Winners will then proceed to next stage.
- Teams progressed to next group stage. Please take note that points earned from Round-Robin preliminary stage will not be brought forward.
- Each team requires minimum of 4 players, in proper attire and with shin pads (A Must) on court to start a match. Referees will start the match with no delays.



- Every Team Captain/Manager must sign off the result scorecard at the end of their match (Compulsory).
- If a match at full-time ends in a draw, no extra-time will be given and it will be recorded as a draw during the Preliminary Rounds only.



In case of a draw in points in preliminaries, order of checking:

Knock-Out Rounds Onwards (A tie after full-time)

- Sudden Death 1-min Open Play of 3v3. If there is still no winner, we will carry on with 1-min 2v2 and subsequently 1-min of 1v1.
- Goals can be scored from anywhere of the field of play, except from kick-in.
- Goalkeepers are only allowed to underhand throws.
- Sliding tackles are NOT allowed.

Substitution

- Substitutions are only allowed during a stoppage in each match.
- Substitution will be allowed at any time with prior approval and acknowledgement of the Referee.
- There will be no limit of the number of substitutions

Walkover

- A team shall concede a walkover if they fail to register or put a minimum of 4 players or no show at all in the first 2 mins of each scheduled time of play (announcements will be made)
- The decision of the Referees will be final.
- If any team, gives a walk-over during the tournament, 3 points will be awarded to the team present.
- A 3-0 result will be awarded to the other team should a walkover happens.
- A Team that gives 2 or more consecutive walk-over during their group stages games will be disqualified, and their scores will be recorded as null & void for the entire tournament.

Caution/Send Off

- Any player who received 2 cautions (yellow card) during the tournament matches shall be suspended for the next existing match.
- Any player who is "sent off" (Red Card) by the referee will be suspended for the next 2 existing matches (If any).
- In the event of violent conduct offence by any player, team manager and supporter of the team, the entire Team will be disqualified from the tournament.
- In the event of any verbal abuse by any player in the team towards any staffs / officials / opposing players, the player will be disqualified from the Tournament.



Ethics

- Team Manager/Captain/Coach is responsible for the proper control and good conduct of his players and supporters. He shall also serve as the team's representatives in matters pertaining to the tournament.
- Players should understand and abide by all the Rules and Regulations of the Game and the Tournament.
- Players must always abide by the decision of the Referees. Referees' decision is final.
- Players may be disqualified for breaching any of the above-mentioned Rules.

Attire

- Players are to be in proper football attire with long socks, boots / futsal shoes / turf shoes & shin pads (Compulsory). Chains and accessories on the players' body are to be removed prior to your match.
- Spectacles and Bangles (religious) are to be worn at your own risks.
- The first named Team on the schedule shall be the Home Team. The Home Team should put on the jersey contrast in colour to those of the opponents.
- Teams must have a minimum of one set of Jerseys. If both teams arrive at a match dressed in Jerseys of the same colour, the home team must change or bibs will be provided.

<u>Disputes / Protests / Complaints / Appeals</u>

- The Tournament Committee (TC) shall only entertain protest put up by the Team Manager.
- Any protest against the opposing team shall be lodged by the Team Manager regarding submission on the eligibility of players during or before the said match. It should be made BEFORE or DURING the tournament. All protests that come AFTER the results has been finalised would not be entertained. This should facilitate verification on the eligibility of the players concerned.

Wet Weather

- In the event of inclement weather, Organisers will make a decision to proceed or delay the tournament.
- In the event of inclement weather, such as, lightning and/or heavy rain (CAT 1), the Management reserves the right to stop all activities. We will, however, cancel the event if there is a delay of more than two hours.
- If wet weather happens during preliminary rounds, we will wait a maximum of two hours. We will proceed as long as the chief referee deems the pitch to be playable.
- If wet weather happens during Finals, at the point of cancellation, whichever team is leading will win.



Tournament Jurisdiction:

- Organiser and Tournament Director reserve the right to interpret or amend the rules and regulations of the tournament at any time.
- While reasonable precautions will be taken, the Organisers, support crew and staff will
 not be responsible or in any way liable for any death, disability, personal injury, loss of
 property or any other loss, howsoever arising from any cause whatsoever at any time
 during the course of this tournament.
