Event Category

Aged 16 to 26 years old
 Mixed with min of 4 males and 4 females in a team.
A max of 10 players per team

- Minimum of 16 teams and maximum of 32 teams
- In the event where minimum number of teams is not met, the organiser has the rights to decide whether or not the event shall be cancelled.

Eligibility of Players

- This tournament is open for all nationality residing in Singapore.
- Entries are accepted on a first-come-first-serve-basis.
- SAFRA member with a valid membership as of event date to enjoy member's rate.
- The Organiser has the right to check the eligibility of a player during the tournament. Anyone found to have breach the eligibility criteria shall be disqualified from the tournament.

Tournament Format:

Round Robin followed by Knock Out

- Scoring system Game will be to 7 points or 20 minutes
- Each team may take one (1) time-out per game. A time-out lasts forty-five (45) seconds.
- Half time occurs after the first team reaches half time target of four (4) goals or after ten (10) minutes of game time.
- At half time cap play continues until the completion of the current point. If at the completion of the current point neither team has reached four (4) goals, one (1) goal is added to the highest score to determine a half time cap target.
- The game continues until a team reaches the half time cap target, and then Mirror Half occurs.
- No half time duration (Mirror Half).
- Teams will be re-seeded after the pool stage (Win/Lose > Goal Difference > Goal Scored>Disc Toss)
- Time cap: If time is up BEFORE the score and AFTER the score (completion of current point). If any team is up by 1, Game ends. If score is tied. Play the final point. If time is up AFTER a score and BEFORE the pull, point must still be played as next point has commenced after the previous score.
- The game clock does not stop for time between points, time-outs or half time, but does stop for Spirit Stoppages, and once an injury stoppage or technical stoppage has lasted more than two (2) minutes. The game clock must restart once play restarts.
- A game that involves a significant number of calls, especially when these remain disputed, should be brought to the attention of the Tournament Director by a captain as soon as possible. The TD determines whether further action should be taken against teams or individuals.
- If there are repeated Dangerous Plays from a team, or there is an egregious Dangerous Play, team Captains and Spirit Captains should meet to discuss how to address this.

<u>Gender Ratio Rule</u> – Gender ratio will be strictly 3 Males / 3 Females on the field, at all times. Any other alternate ratio must be communicated and agreed by both captains before the start of the game.

- (A7.4) If a point has commenced and a team does not have exactly (5) people playing the point, or does not have the correct gender ratio, then the opposition may call a violation and stop play, or the infringing team may use a time-out to address the issue (as per Rule 20.4).
- The infringing team must choose which of their player(s) will be removed/added. If players are being added, the opposition may make the same number of substitutions to their team.
- If a violation is called, the opposition must choose either to restart play as if a time out had been called (as per Rule 20.3), or to restart the point.
- If a violation of A7.4 is called after a goal has been scored and prior to the ensuing pull, the opposition may choose to nullify the goal and restart the point.



Walkover

- A team shall concede a walkover if they fail to register or put a minimum of 5 players on the line in the first 1 min of each game.
- A 7-0 result will be awarded to the other team should a walkover happens.

Wet Weather

- In the event of inclement weather, Organisers will make a decision to proceed or delay the tournament.
- If wet weather happens after completion of round robin, championship will be decided based on round robin results.
- If wet weather happens during the reseeding stage (i.e. Quarter-finals/Semi Finals), all completed games (by stage) will add on to the overall standings which includes the group stages.
- If wet weather happens during round robin stage and games can go on after, complete the round robin stage. If there is a time constraint, complete round robins stage. Championship will be decided based on the round robin results.
- If wet weather happens during Finals, at the point of cancellation, whichever team is leading will win.

Tournament Jurisdiction:

- Organiser and Tournament Director reserve the right to interpret or amend the rules and regulations of the tournament at any time.
- While reasonable precautions will be taken, the Organisers, support crew and staff will
 not be responsible or in any way liable for any death, disability, personal injury, loss of
 property or any other loss, howsoever arising from any cause whatsoever at any time
 during the course of this tournament.
